- c) used to live in Dennington but has been forced to move away because of the lack of affordable housing
- d) is employed in socially beneficial employment in Dennington
- e) has any other link with Dennington considered suitable by the Orwell Housing.

Should no one qualify under those conditions then the Association can widen their net using the same connections as set out above with the parishes of Saxtead, Badingham, Bruisyard, Cransford, Rendham and Swaffling.
